## Dan Bull Inspirational Talk Incursion Monday 11th February 2019

Dear parents of Grade 5/6 Students,

As part of our leadership program, we have organised a well known Adventurer, Daniel Bull to come and speak to the students. The main focus of this incursion is **goal setting**, **resilience**, **leadership**, **teamwork and overcoming adversity**. We feel that these are very important to help the students transition into their leadership roles at Wallington Primary School.

This incursion will take place at school on Monday the 11th of February 2019.

Dan Bull is an Adventurer and explorer who has recently been awarded the Guinness World Record for becoming the Youngest Person to Climb the Highest Mountain, such as Mount Everest, and the Highest Volcano on every continent. He's the First Australian to achieve the feat. More people have stood on the moon. And he has done it all whilst overcoming a debilitating childhood condition to demonstrate firsthand that anything is possible.

Dan's presentation will go for around 60 minutes and will include a talk, question and answer opportunity and a chance for students to have their photo taken. The school will also receive a signed copy of the Guinness World Records 2019.

The cost of this excursion will be \$10 per student. Payments will need to be made no later than Wednesday 6th February 2019.
